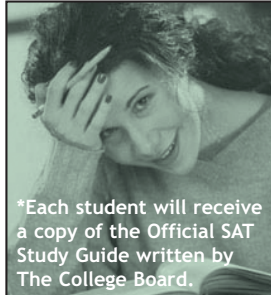


The SAT, along with your GPA, transcript and recommendations are the factors used by most colleges to help decide whether or not to admit students. Not all schools require the SAT, but the great majority do. In fact, at many colleges, the SAT is the primary factor in determining not only your acceptance, but also, what scholarships you may be eligible to receive. For better or worse, your SAT score will have a tremendous impact on your future.

Giving you the skills you need to excel on the SAT, Community Programs will again be offering the SAT Prep Course leading up to the May 1, 2010, SAT test date.

The classes will meet Monday and Wednesday evenings as listed on the reverse side. There will be 10 Math sessions and 8 Verbal sessions. Classes begin February 3 and are conducted through April 21. In the event classes are cancelled due to inclement weather, make-up classes will be announced and scheduled prior to the May 1 test.

Teachers from the East Brunswick Public Schools faculty will be teaching the courses. The cost of the course is \$299 if registered on or before January 15 and \$329 if registered after January 15. The last day to register is Monday, February 1. This course is offered at a considerable savings when compared to commercially offered SAT Prep courses. Students who qualify for free/reduced lunch should contact the Office of Community Programs to obtain information regarding a discount.

Students wishing/needing to cancel their enrollment in the SAT Prep Course must do so in writing no later than February 3, 2010; a \$15 registration fee will be deducted. Refunds will not be issued after February 3.

All students will be assigned to their requested session. Classroom lists will be posted in the high school rotunda fifteen minutes before each Math session on February 3 and fifteen minutes before each Verbal session on February 8.

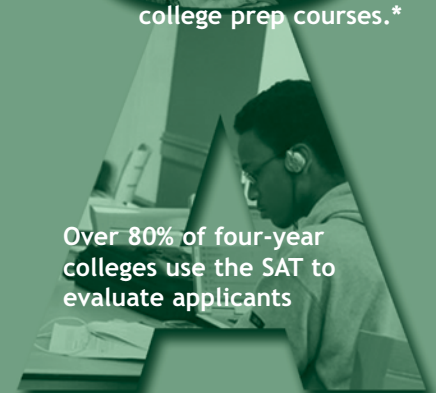
