

## Summer Camp 2009

The Office of Community Programs offers a summer camp experience for those who have completed kindergarten through those who have completed fifth grade. **The camp will be located at Lawrence Brook School and will begin each day immediately after Summer Academy.**

The camp will offer an inclusive environment designed to ensure each camper a safe and enjoyable experience. All of the camp activities have been selected to provide opportunities for children to participate, build new skills, form friendships, and gain self-confidence. Qualified staff and a wide range of activities will provide developmental structure for social, physical, and personal skill development.

Only children registered and paid may attend the program. Summer Academy children will be escorted to camp immediately after classes. Participants must bring their own lunch. Extended School Year students will be bused to Lawrence Brook and escorted to camp.

Each participant must be signed out by the custodial adult at the end of each day.

### Lunch

Students should bring lunch and a drink each day. A healthy snack will be provided.

### Withdrawal from the Program

Should withdrawal from the program be necessary, written notice must be sent to the Office of Community Programs.
