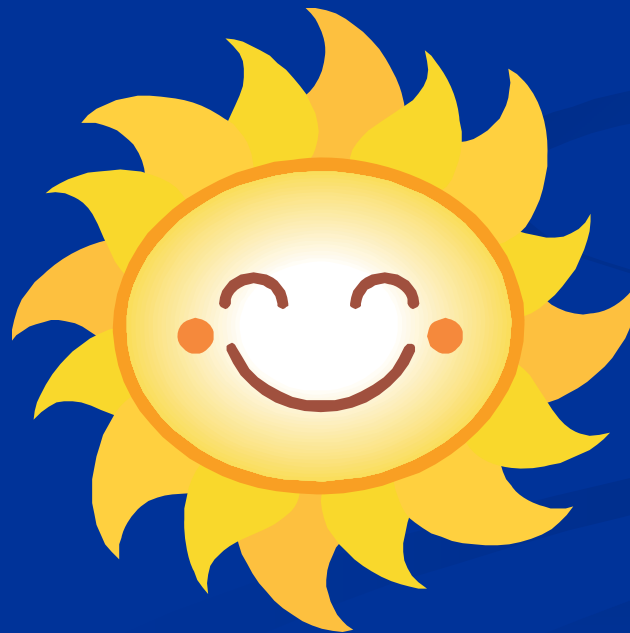

- **No more than 2 absences**

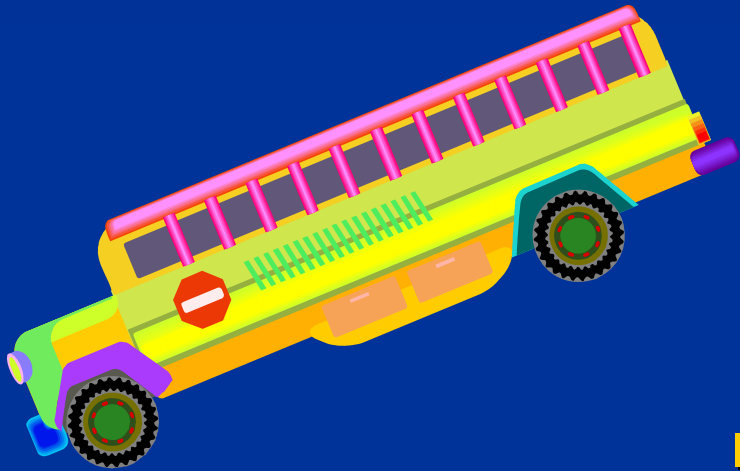
