- 2. Drop-In Academic Support and Tutoring Services: Extra help is available in math, English, science, social studies, world language courses and electives on Tuesdays-Thursdays from 2:45-3:45 PM. This extra help service is provided free of charge to all students and students do not need to make an appointment for extra help. Please CLICK HERE for a list by subject area with room locations where extra help is offered. This extra help is a great opportunity for students who need assistance with homework, studying for a test, preparing for midterms, or catching up due to an absence. Please encourage your child to attend if they are in need of extra help.
- 3. 2024-2025 Course Guide and Scheduling Process for Next Year: The online course request module for next year's scheduling is now open in Parent Access and will remain open through February 21st. Please remember to make all course selections including elective courses before pressing the green submit button in the scheduling module. The online course guide for the 2024-2025 school year is available on the district website under the Department of Academics. Information and resources related to scheduling can be found on our school homepage and our school counseling webpage. I want to stress that submitting course requests early in the scheduling process does not prioritize or guarantee a spot in a class for next year. Please take time to discuss scheduling requests with your child before submitting your selections.
- **4. Churchill Junior High School PTA News:** Please join the PTA at our next meeting on Wednesday, January 24th at 6:30 PM in the Churchill Cafeteria. There will be a presentation from Solutions Prep on navigating the road to the college path. It will include useful information for parents of all grades.
- **5. EBHS** *Rising* **10**th **Grade Parent Night:** I was notified late this afternoon that the EBHS Administrative Team will need to move the date of the *Rising* 10th Grade Parent Night. I will communicate the new date when I receive the information from the high school.

6. Midterm Exams: Midterm exams will take place on January 23-26 at CJHS. Most 7th grade students will not take a formal midterm exam except for a few classes such as Algebra I Honors. Some 7th grade classes may administer a common assessment during the exam period to assess student learning from marking period 2. Other 7th grade classes may use the exam period to continue with regular instruction. 7th grade teachers will be communicating with their classes about the format of any assessments for the end of marking period 2. Exam days are single session days for students with dismissal at 12:32 PM. No lunch is served on exam days for grades 7-12. The schedule that we will use on midterm exam days is shown below:
