The Counseling Department will be changing how they communicate with students and teachers regarding student appointments. Students are encouraged to download the Outlook app on their smart phone and login with their ebnet login information. Students will still be able to request an appointment with their counselor by filling out an appointment request form in the Counseling office or by filling out an online Google Form through the Counseling Canvas page. Students will receive their scheduled appointment notification via email and Outlook Calendar. Additionally, each school counselor has created a 24/7 online presence through virtual counseling offices which include links to Counseling forms and resources.
