

## **Parent Communication – 2019 Back to School Night**

Good evening! This is Dr. Vinella, Principal of East Brunswick High School calling to invite all high school parents to our annual Back-to-School Night Program on Thursday, September 19th at 7:00 p.m.

The Back to School Night Program will begin at 7:00 p.m. and parents should report directly to your child's Period 1 class. You then follow his/her schedule for the rest of the evening. During Period 2, I will make a short TV presentation during homeroom. On Wednesday, your son or daughter will be given a schedule to bring home and if needed, you can access it on Parent Access.

Our Back-to-School Night Program is presented to all 10th through 12th grade parents on the same evening because many of our classes are mixed grades. It is because of this that entering school grounds and parking is tight. The police and our security staff will be directing traffic to help ensure your arrival and departure is safe and efficient. As such, I would ask that you keep the following items in mind:

- Parents should use both the Summerhill and Cranbury Road entrances and follow the directions of the police and security staff to parking.

- If at all possible, parents are encouraged to carpool as a way to help minimize the number of cars.

- For security purposes to enter the building, you may use the three entrances: (1) main entrance in the front of the building, (2) I hall in the back, or (3) the cafeteria patio on the Summerhill side of the building.
