A NOTE FROM THE ATTENDANCE OFFICE

- If your child is younger than 18 years of age, and will be absent, a parent/guardian <u>must</u> call the
 attendance office and report the absence. Emails <u>will not</u> be accepted to report absences.
 Please be sure to include the spelling of your child's name, grade and reason for absence.
- When a student arrives late to school after 8:20, they must sign into the attendance office.
- When a student is absent due to illness, a note from a parent/guardian must be provided in order for the absence to be excused. If a student is out more than 3 consecutive days, a doctor's note must be obtained. All notes must be received from a parent/guardian that is identified in Genesis within 5 school days of the absence. Students must bring the note into school and put it in the attendance box outside the main office.
- College visits will be excused if documentation is provided from the school stating that the student went on a tour of the school (emails/paper copy accepted).
- Academic Programs/Competitions/Sports tournaments may also be excused pending approval prior to the absence from your student's Grade Level Administrator with the proper documentation (paperwork from school and a handwritten note from parent/guardian)
- Please note- The number of absences have been reduced- 10 for a full year course 5 for a semester course and 3 for a quarter course
- When a student needs to be picked up during school hours, please provide them with a note stating the time and the reason for dismissal. They can bring the note to the attendance office in the morning and we will provide them with a pass to leave class. If a student is 18 years of age, they can sign themselves out and the attendance office will give a courtesy call to the parent/guardian identified in Genesis.
 - Please be advised that a phone call will be sent home notifying parent(s)/guardian when a student is marked absent in homeroom.
