

EBHS Grading Clarifications for Students & Parent

For our secondary students, grades will be recorded, and a report card will be issued. Grades will be based on participation and assignments. All students will be exempt from final exams. Students will be graded weekly so they can track their progress in each class. Teachers will update grades in Genesis weekly. Parent Access will remain viewable. Students may request a course be graded Pass/Fail for 4th marking period by contacting their teacher and/or school counselor.

- Students can take a full year, semester 2, or quarter 4 course pass/fail as outlined in the EBHS Student Handbook. The deadline for choosing to take a course pass/fail will be extended to May 8, 2020.
- Pass/Fail Grading for Marking Period 4 – A student may select 1 course in their schedule to have their marking period 4 grade calculated using Pass/Fail. If the student chooses to have their grade in a course recorded as Pass/Fail for Marking Period 4, the student will notify their teacher and school counselor. Grading will be calculated as follows:
 - If student earns a ‘P’ for MP 4. The MP 4 grade posted in Genesis will be a ‘P’ and the final grade posted in Genesis will be calculated as follows:
 - MP 1 – 2/7 (approximately 28.6%)
 - MP 2 – 2/7 (approximately 28.6%)
 - Midterm Exam – 1/7 (approximately 14.3%)
 - MP 3 – 2/7 (approximately 28.6%)
 - If a student earns an ‘F’ for MP 4 the final grade for the class posted in Genesis will be calculated as follows:
 - MP 1 – 2/9 (approximately 22.2%)
 - MP 2 – 2/9 (approximately 22.2%)
 - Midterm Exam – 1/9 (approximately 11.1%)
 - MP 3 – 2/9 (approximately 22.2%)
 - MP 4 – 2/9 (approximately 22.2%)
