
Registration Information

This program provides parents of 3 and 4 year-old toilet-trained children the opportunity to register their child for a 5 day/week, developmentally appropriate early learning experience within the school district. This fee-based, parent-pay program includes half-day, extended half-day and full-day options. In addition, the Early Morning Program (EMP) will be available beginning at 7:00 a.m., and the After School Kids (ASK) program until 6 p.m.

The curriculum design and implementation is based on the New Jersey Department of Education's *Preschool Teaching and Learning Standards* and the *Preschool Implementation Guidelines*. Certified supervisors with expertise in the field of early childhood and school readiness oversee the planning and preparation for the program. The plans are implemented by experienced and caring staff, most of whom hold teacher certification.
