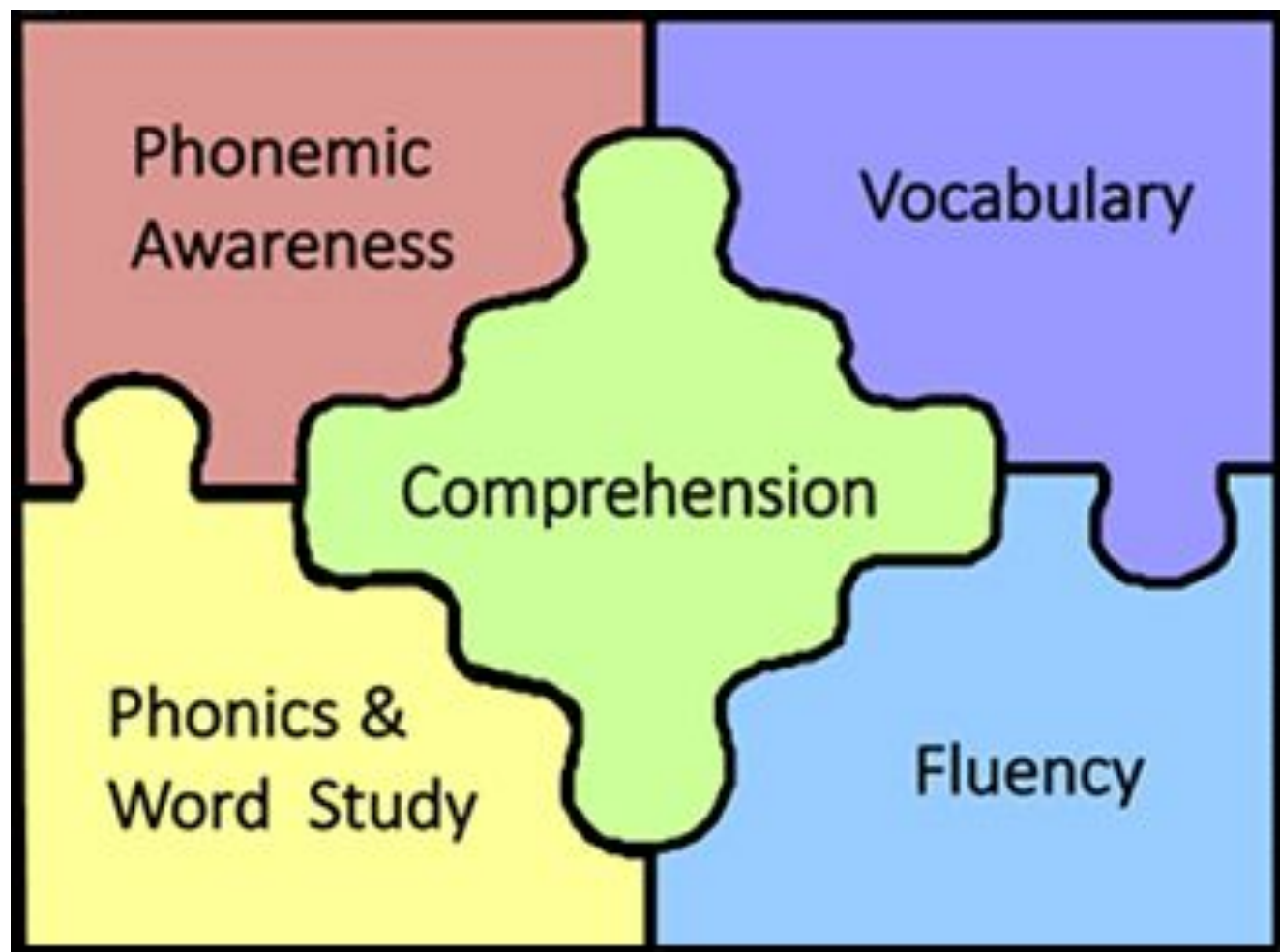


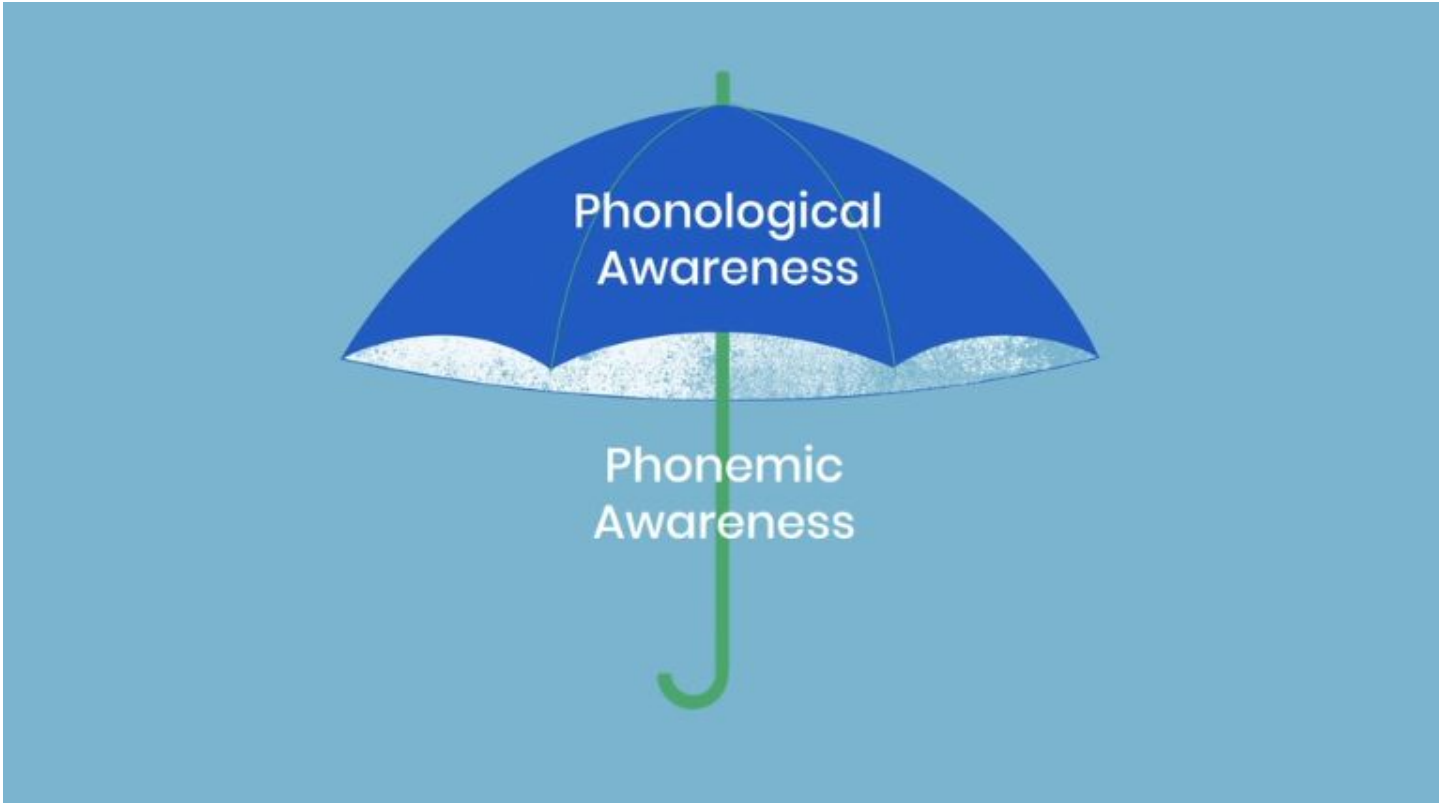

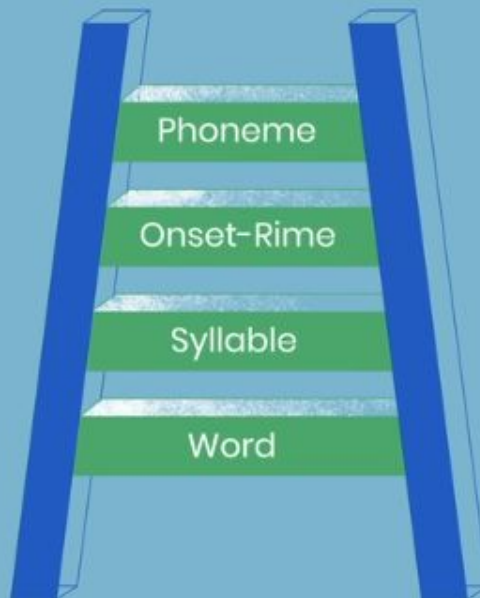


Phonological Awareness

Supporting Your Child at Home

- No materials are needed
- The games or activities last for 5- 10 minutes
- This can be incorporated into your normal routines
 - While making dinner
 - Driving to practice
 - At bedtime
 - During an after school snack
- Activities can transition into phonics practice once phonemic awareness is strengthened.

Rhyming

- I'm Thinking of a Word
 - "I'm thinking of a word that rhymes with dot. It's used for cooking. The word is _____ (pot)"
- Rhyme Challenge game
 - "Let's see how many words we can rhyme with lake. Try to beat your score from last time!"
 - Bake, cake, take, make, fake, etc.
- I Spy
 - "I spy with my little eye something that rhymes with tree."
 - Play while driving, while in the supermarket, looking through a book or magazine.

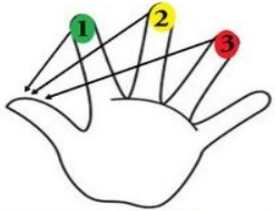
Isolating Sounds

- Start this work with beginning sounds, moving to final sounds, and when ready medial or middle sounds.
- Hand motions are used in school
 - Punch It Out for final sounds
 - Rollercoaster for middle sounds
- Guess My Word
 - Play game when: making dinner, making grocery list, looking for something in the room, packing lunch, driving in the car
 - Okay, I'm thinking of a word that begins with /z/ and it is an animal with stripes (zebra)

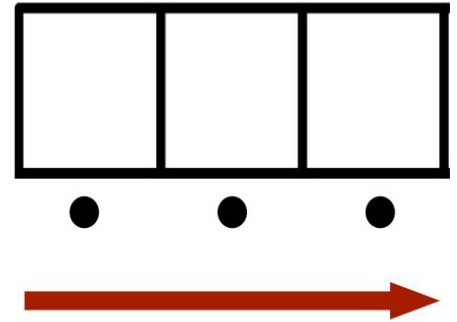
Blending and Segmenting

- Use these activities to blend and segment words and syllables. These words can come from your surroundings (ex: kitchen, playground, bedroom)
- Use words and practice breaking apart the syllable or sound. Then blend the sounds and syllables together using:

Manipulating Sounds

- Manipulating sounds consists of adding, deleting, or substituting a sound from a word
- Start this work with beginning sounds and move toward ending sounds
- Hand motions support this work
- Adding Example:
 - Say oat, add /b/. The word is boat
- Deleting Example:
 - Say goat, take away /t/. The word is go
- Substituting Example:
 - Say cake, change the /c/ to /b/. The word is bake
